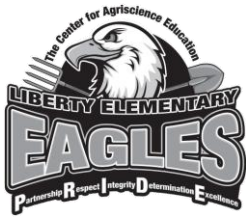

ITEM #2, NEW BUSINESS-CARNIVAL RECAP:

- L. Shea to provide cash flow report at December Meeting which will show the monies spent versus monies received.
- It was a great turn out as usual-we did however notice a slight decline in attendance this year but feel that might be due to the handful of families and/or students that we did lose
- Boutique was a nice touch and addition to this years' event.
 - Members mentioned there was little advertisement for this though and encourage more advertisement should this be something brought back in years to come
